Parent Code of Conduct

As a NWCBA Parent, I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for each child participating in NWCBA by adhering to the following:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support at all times.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun, and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, umpire, coach, player or parent such as booing or taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
- I will respect each umpire and his/her authority during games.
- I will not confront coaches at any time during games.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games.
- I will abide by the NWCA policy prohibiting alcoholic beverages at any NWCBA event.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I may be subject to disciplinary action levied by the NWCBA Board of Directors (or Policy Committee thereof) that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal Warning
- Written Warning
- Suspension for one or more events
- Season suspension
- Removal from one or more events

The NWCBA Board of Directors retains the sole authority to determine what, if any, disciplinary action is appropriate for any conduct infraction.
